

Placing Each Student At the Right Level: Based on current level of Literacy Skills (see ahead two pages for Numeracy)

With almost 20,000 pages of resources, suitable for students of all ages and special needs, it is important to know where to begin. Usually, the teacher, teacher's assistant or parent has an excellent awareness of each student's current academic functioning level. This table will help you to locate the most suitable resources for each student, **based on their current level of academic functioning** (NOT based on their age or current school year).

However, you can also administer our simple **“Placement and Progress Tests for Literacy”** if you would like to place your student more precisely. This method also allows you another mechanism for tracking the student's progress over time. Simply re-administer the assessment tests every six to twelve months to record and evaluate progress.
